DAYS 1 & 2 - PART ONE

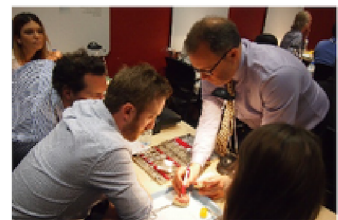
This pre-clinical program will consist of lectures, hands-on manikin workshops (on mounted bone models with sinus cavities membrane and synthetic soft tissue) to allow a uniform set of clinical procedures to be taught in a controlled, simulated clinical environment, including live surgery video and participant's case presentations over two full days.

This program will concentrate on the management of the most commonly encountered clinical problems during implant surgery.
