Speaker Biography:

Dr Luan Ngo BDSoc. (Hons) Ph.D. DCLinDent. FRACDS (Perio)

Luan is a registered periodontist based in Carlton, Victoria. Luan was formerly the convenor of the Doctor of Clinical Dentistry (Periodontics) program at the Melbourne Dental School, and is still heavily involved in teaching. Luan is a council member of the ASPVB, the Australian and New Zealand Academy of Periodontists, and is on the Board of Studies (Periodontics) for the Royal Australasian College of Dental Surgeons.

TOPIC:

Salvage operation - extending the life of failing implant restorations.

Dental implant retained restorations are commonly used for the replacement of missing teeth. Whilst we would want them to last forever, the reality is that peri-implantitis (which can lead to pain, morbidity and potentially implant loss) is a common occurrence. Whilst the goal may be the arrest of disease, a valid goal of treatment may be to slow down the rate of disease progression and extend the life of failing implant restorations. This talk will explore factors which may be important in achieving this goal and what is required in practice.
